WHAT MAKES OUR CAMP SPECIAL?

We offer an educational, hands-on horse camp for children. We have programs for the beginner as well as the advanced equestrian student.

Students will learn the basics of horsemanship, horse safety, care and grooming, and most of all they will have great time.

Safety is our ultimate priority! Each session is limited to ensure proper supervision. Side-walkers are available for beginning students until they are able to control their horses. Horses are selected for their gentle personalities. Our safety record is unbroken, and riders leave camp happy and well informed.

Riding counselors:

Participants will be helping with instruction, demonstrating proper
horsemanship, and being mentors for the campers. They will also be helping with
daily barn chores, horse management, and exercising and feeding programs. They
will also be participating in daily riding activities.

Non-riding counselors:

Participants will be helping with instruction, demonstrating proper horsemanship, and being mentors for the campers. They will also be helping with daily barn chores, horse management, and exercising and feeding programs. These participants will not take part in the riding portion of the daily schedule.

All participants must be at least up to at least the advanced level class in the Double Diamond Riding School and be at least 10 yrs of age.

REGISTRATION

- Space is limited so call early to reserve your slot.
- Full tuition of \$200 per child per riding session is due along with registration form before the counselor will have a slot reserved.
- If signing up for multiple riding sessions, tuition is discounted to \$150 per session.
- Refer to the summer camp page on our website for all necessary enrollment forms and paperwork.
- Bring remaining completed forms on the first day of camp. Children will not be allowed to stay, if paperwork is not completed.
- All tuition is NON REFUNDABLE. However, we understand that circumstances can change that my cause a camper to not be able to participate. If notice is received before registration for the camp ends, then we will be happy to credit the student's account for the half of amount of the tuition. This credit can be used towards any services that DDEC provides. The credited amount must be used within a 60 day time that the notice is given or that money will be forfeited. Again, no money will be refunded.

NO EXCEPTIONS!

IMPORTANT THINGS TO NOTE

- Counselors should arrive promptly at 8:30am, and be picked up at 5:00pm.
- Each child must wear slick sole boots, jeans or riding pants, and SUNSCREEN.
- Riding helmets ARE REQUIRED! If you choose to purchase one for your child, you may purchase them at troxelhelmets.com. Helmets may be rented from us for \$25/ week.
- Please make sure that your child eats a good breakfast before he/she comes to camp.

THINGS TO BRING EVERYDAY

- 1. Water jug
- 2. Morning & Afternoon snack
- 3. Healthy Lunch
- 4. Riding helmet (not a bicycle helmet)
- 5. Swim suit, towel, and tennis shoes
- 6. Boots and jeans
- 7. A change of clothes including socks
- 8. Sunscreen

CAN I STAY TO WATCH MY CHILD?

The safety of your child is our first priority. We CANNOT have parents or siblings staying with the children. Our full attention needs to be on the campers and nothing else. You are welcome to attend the last day for the "open barn" to see what your child has teaching. The open barn is from 3:30-4:00pm on Friday. After they are finished on Friday, they are welcome to be picked up early. Please make sure that any other children that come with you stay in the observation area with you at all times. We have many other horses on the premises and cannot be responsible for their safety. Also, dogs are NEVER allowed on the property!
